The U.S. Probation Service, Northern District of Mississippi, is accepting applications for two full-time, permanent positions for U.S. Probation Officers.

Qualifications :

Bachelor's Degree with Masters Degree preferred from an accredited college or university in Criminal Justice, Counseling, Psychology, Sociology, Political Science, Education, Rehabilitation, Management, or Law. Experience in corrections, counseling, rehabilitation, drug/alcohol or personnel/human services work is preferred. Applicants must have good writing and computer skills. Testing is required.

Prior to appointment, the selectee will undergo a background investigation, a medical examination, and drug screening. Upon successful completion, the selectee may then be appointed provisionally, pending a favorable determination by the court. Selectee will be subject to ongoing random drug screening, updated background investigations every five years, and may be subject to subsequent fitness-for-duty evaluations. This position is considered hazardous duty employment; therefore, Federal Employment Practice prohibits the hiring of anyone past age 36.
