The Northern District of Mississippi's clerk's office at the Greenville Federal Building & Courthouse will cease providing most public services, effective at the close of business Friday, September 30, 2005.

The court's public-access computer terminal, its case-file microfiche cards and a card reader, and a photocopier and printer will be available in the Greenville clerk's office lobby.

Greenville court case files will be made available for review by appointment only. Call the Oxford clerk's office at (662) 234-1971 to schedule an appointment or to resolve problems that may arise from this closing.

The Greenville clerk's office will not accept payments for any services. All payments, including civil action filing fees, must be delivered to the clerk's office in Oxford or Aberdeen.

This closing is attributable to federal fiscal constraints requiring reductions in force of court-support personnel.
