THE DESIGNATION OF COURTROOM SPACE

ORDER

More than two years ago this Court was compelled to evacuate its regular courthouse in Aberdeen, Mississippi due to the presence of mold that adversely affected the health of Court staff and posed a continued threat to those working in the building. This evacuation has disrupted the work of the Court, in among other ways, by reducing the available number of courtrooms in the Northern District by three. There are now no available courtrooms within the Aberdeen Division dedicated to the use of this Court and the two District Judges and the Magistrate Judge assigned to the Division.

The Court is presently housed in offices at the Gilmore Foundation Conference Center at 203 Gilmore Drive, Amory, Mississippi. In order to ameliorate the impact of the lack of courtroom space, the Court, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 141(a)(1) hereby designates Conference Room A, at these offices, as “Courtroom 1” for the holding of such special sessions as may hereafter be noticed. This Order shall remain in effect through December 31, 2020.
