FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: JUROR QUALIFICATION QUESTIONNAIRE.

What do I do if ...

- I no longer live in Mississippi? Please complete the form with your new address and answer the questions. This will remove you from our jury pool. However, you will need to contact the county in which you were registered to vote to remove your name from that list.
- **I have a new address?** Update your address on eJuror or write the new address on the form and return to us.
- The addressee no longer lives at this address? If you know the addressee you may forward it to them for their response; if you do not know the addressee, please write on the envelope "no forwarding address" and return to us.
- The addressee is deceased? You may log in to eJuror and answer the questions for the deceased person. When it asks if the person is deceased, answer "yes" along with the date of death and this will update our system. You may also write "deceased" on the envelope and return to us.
- I have a permanent physical/mental ailment that will prevent me from serving as a juror? In eJuror, mark "Yes" in response to the Medical question. If you are able to have a doctor sign the Physician's Statement for Medical Excuse please do so and return to us by mail; or you may fax it to 662/236-4550. If you are unable to obtain a doctor's signature please send an e-mail to juryinfo@msnd.uscourts.gov.
- This will create a hardship for my job? You can request an excuse for an employment hardship if/when you receive a summons at a later date. We are not able to excuse you for this situation at this stage.
- I am a caregiver for young children, elderly, etc.? You can request an excuse as a caregiver if/when you receive a summons at a later date. We are not able to excuse you for this situation at this stage.
- I have no transportation or do not drive? You can request an excuse for lack of transportation if/when you receive a summons at a later date. We are not able to excuse you for this situation at this stage.
- There are certain dates that I will not be able to report? This is not a summons for you to report at this time. You will be able to request an excuse for any dates that you will not be available if/when you receive a summons.
